## CLUB TRAILERS

Team Mount Beauty (TMB) own a fleet of trailers for transporting bikes. As of early 2022 the fleet consists of:

- 3x Shingleback 20 bike trailers
- 2x custom crank-holder 22 bike trailers

TMB intends for these trailers to be available for use by club members and organisations. The TMB Committee reserves the right to apply a hire fee at its sole discretion, acknowledging the following general principles for waiving the hire fee:

- The hirer is a current member of TMB; and
- The trailer is to be used:
  - By an educational institution located in the Upper Kiewa Valley; or
  - In the Upper Kiewa Valley for philanthropic or community oriented purposes.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TRAILER USAGE

1. The Hirer must have a full and current Australian drivers license appropriate to the tow vehicle (ie not learner or probationary level).
  - a. Copy of driver's license to be emailed to [info@tmb.org.au](mailto:info@tmb.org.au) with application form.
2. The fee for trailer hire is:
  - a. Shingleback trailer:
    - i. \$125.00 per day or part day incl. GST.
  - b. Custom crank-holder trailer:
    - i. \$55.00 per day or part day incl. GST.

3. The hire fee is to be paid in full via EFT prior to commencement of hire to Team Mount Beauty Inc BSB 633 000 / AC 142 687 045 or PayID [info@tmb.org.au](mailto:info@tmb.org.au).
4. The Hirer is responsible for the Trailer at all times until returned to TMB. The Trailer is not to be given in to the care of another person without prior written approval from TMB.
5. The Trailer is not to be used for commercial purposes.
6. The Hirer is responsible for:
  - a. Ensuring that the tow vehicle is appropriate for towing the Trailer; and
  - b. Ensuring that the Trailer is securely attached to the tow vehicle; and
  - c. Obtaining the correct trailer light socket or converter (The Shingleback trailers have 7-pin rectangular plugs; the Custom trailers have 7-pin round plugs); and
  - d. Ensuring that the Trailer lights are operational; and
  - e. Checking that the Trailer is in roadworthy condition.
7. The Trailer must be returned on or prior to the end of the Hire Period. If there is a delay in returning the Trailer, notify the Trailer Coordinator immediately and make arrangements to return the trailer to the storage area or deliver it to the next hirer. The Hirer may incur an additional hire fee amounting to the number of days (or parts thereof) for which the return of the Trailer is delayed.
8. The Hirer is liable for any traffic or parking infringements or fines incurred during the Hire Period.
9. The Hirer is responsible for the security of the Trailer from the time that the Trailer is collected until the time it is returned:
  - a. If a hire fee is applied the insurance policy held by TMB does not apply, in which case the Hirer is responsible for any and all costs involved in repairing or replacing the Trailer;
  - b. If the Hirer is not a member of Team Mount Beauty, the insurance policy held by TMB does not apply, in which case the Hirer is responsible for any and all costs involved in repairing or replacing the Trailer;

- c. If a hire fee is not applied the insurance policy held by TMB does apply, in which case the insurance excess is \$5,000:
  - i. If an insurable event occurs during the Hire Period, the Hirer is responsible for any and all costs involved in repairing or replacing the Trailer, including the insurance excess;
  - ii. If an uninsured event occurs during the Hire Period, the Hirer is responsible for any and all costs involved in repairing or replacing the Trailer.

10. If the Trailer is damaged during a period of hire then the Hirer must notify the Trailer Coordinator as soon as possible and the Hirer will be responsible for paying the costs of repair (fair wear and tear excluded).

11. Team Mount Beauty accepts no responsibility or liability for damage incurred to bikes or the tow vehicle.
